The project has given our staff member's opportunities to be involved in the following:

- Using a Moodle and starting to create online blended delivery which is suited to our learners with disabilities. It has been most useful to be able to be trained and supported to look at examples of online learning and also be supported to develop some examples of what we could use in the future.
